

Benjamin Franklin was born in Boston in 1706. He had 16 brothers and sisters. His family could not afford to send him to school after he was 10 years old. So he taught himself, from books.

He was interested in everything. He worked as a printer. He also published a newspaper and an almanac (Jahrbuch) full of wit and wisdom. He helped to set up a postal system in America. He did scientific experiments. Some of them were dangerous.

With a kite in a thunderstorm he proved that lightning was electricity. He invented the lightning rod. He made bifocal (two-lens) spectacles.

He helped write the Declaration of Independence (Unabhängigkeitserklärung) in the year 1776 and signed the Constitution (Verfassung). Franklin went to France as the United States ambassador. He died in 1790.
