Prefixes - Vorsilben

The meaning of a word can be changed by adding letters to the beginning of the main word. PRE is a prefix. It comes from Latin meaning *before*.

He <u>ob</u>served his <u>com</u>rades by means of his <u>binoculars</u>. Sue lives in Australia. I communicate with her regularly by email.



The train derailed. His story is rather incredible. I proposed to start early. On a slot machine: Insert 50 cents. He has suffered misfortune all his life. I can't see any obstacles in your way. Until we reach the point of no return. Window panes should be transparent. John likes to keep himself in the foreground. The politician told a lie. Now he is in disgrace. Probably we'll have to postpone our meeting. He spent more money than his income allowed. The telephone is ringing, but nobody ever answers it. Many places of public interest have a visitor's book.
