be	be (Kurzform)	have	have (Kurzform)	can
I am not	I have not	I can't (cannot)
you are not	you have not	you can't
he is not	he has not	he can't
she is not	she has not	she can't
it is not	it has not	it can't
we are not	we have not	we can't
you are not	you have not	you can't
they are not	they have not	they can't

Make the sentences negative:

Sätze verneinen:

Mrs. Miller is a teacher. *Mrs. Miller isn't a teacher.*

There is a museum in our town.

My car has got a British number.

We can see a lot of old cars.

We have got many friends.

Achtung:
must not (mustn't)
bedeutet „darf nicht“
(und nicht „muss nicht“)
You mustn't forget your
passport.

Vollverben werden mit DO umschrieben!

I don't pay	We don't pay
You don't pay	You don't pay
He / She / it doesn't pay	They don't pay

Die verneinte Befehlsform
beginnt immer mit:

Don't... (oder **Do not...**)

Don't forget your passport
Don't play football in the street.
Don't be late.
Do not lean out of the window.

Translate:

come - drink - drive - **eat** - fly - forget - go - make - play - sleep

Ich esse nicht. *I don't eat.* Ihr trinkt nicht.

Du schlafst nicht. Sie spielen nicht.

Er geht nicht. Ben und Sue kommen nicht.

Sie fährt nicht. Vergiss den Schlüssel nicht.

Wir fliegen nicht. Mach keinen Lärm.
